
Installation completion diagram









\* Do not tighten the bolts in this step for the convenience of subsequent installation steps.












### \* Mounting direction







Installation completion diagram

Mount the seat and the seat supporting plates together.




Mount the seat supporting plates to the rig.




<sup>\*</sup>Tighten all the fasteners in the previous steps.


### a. Seat position adjustment




### b. Steering wheel position adjustment










\* The flatter angle of the pedal (-12° — 5°) base is suitable for pedals with a more vertical pedal surface (such as CONSPIT CGP&CPP).
